A recent poll conducted by WPA Intelligence on behalf of the Club for Growth shows Nick Freitas in a strong position to win if there is a Republican Primary for the CD 7 nomination.

Freitas has the highest name ID of any Republican candidate in the district, including state senator and former statewide candidate Bryce Reeves.

Nick Freitas has 41% name ID and 27% of likely Republican primary voters have favorable impressions of him while just 2% have unfavorable impressions.

Bryce Reeves also has high name ID, but his favorable are lower and his unfavorable higher than Freitas's.

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Freitas has a strong, double-digit, lead on the ballot with 23% of voters already committed to voting for him.

Freitas is winning 23% of the likely primary vote with Bryce Reeves in second place at 11% and John McGuire at 9%.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 400 likely special Republican primary election voters in Virginia CD 7. Respondents were contacted via live telephone interview on May 13-15, 2019 with 45% of the interviews conducted via cell phone. The survey has a margin of error of 4.9%. Sample was selected from the Virginia voter file with the probability of selection being equal to the probability of voting in the special election in WPAi's turnout model for this race. Sample was stratified by age, gender, and geography to ensure accurate representation of the district.
