SUBJECT: VICTORIA SPARTZ HAS A SIZEABLE LEAD IN THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY IN INDIANA CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 5

DATE: MAY 14, 2020

A recent poll of Republican primary voters in Indiana Congressional District 5 conducted by WPAi on behalf of Club for Growth PAC shows Victoria Spartz with a sizeable image advantage and substantial lead on the ballot.

Only three candidates are in the double-digits on the ballot, and Spartz has more than twice the support of either of the other two who have reached double digits.

Victoria Spartz has the highest name ID of any candidate in the primary and the highest favorables.

Spartz has 76% name ID, and a majority of primary voters have heard enough about her to form favorable impressions. Carl Brizzi has nearly the same name ID as Spartz, but more than one-in-five primary voters already view him unfavorably. Beth Henderson has lower name ID than either Spartz or Brizzi.

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Victoria Spartz has built a nearly 20-point advantage on the ballot.

One-third of primary voters would vote for Spartz if the election were held today. Only Spartz, Brizzi and Henderson reach double digits on the ballot and Spartz has more support than Brizzi and Henderson combined.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 409 likely Republican primary voters in Indiana CD5. Interviews were conducted via live telephone interview from May 11-13, 2020; 47% of the interviews were conducted to cell phones and 53% to landline phones. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.9\%$. The sample was selected from the voter file and stratified by age, gender, and geography to ensure accurate representation of the electorate.
