SUBJECT: THOMAS MASSIE HAS BUILT A COMMANDING LEAD IN THE KY-4 REPUBLICAN PRIMARY

**DATE:** JUNE 12, 2020

The recent poll conducted by WPAi on behalf of Club for Growth PAC shows conservative Congressman Thomas Massie extending his commanding lead in the Republican primary in Kentucky CD 4.

Massie remains well-liked by Republican primary voters in his district.

Thomas Massie remains well-liked by Republican primary voters with two-thirds saying they have favorable opinions of him and just 16% saying they have unfavorable opinions.

## Primary voters have become increasingly negative toward Todd McMurtry.

McMurtry's name ID has increased by ten points since April, but not to his benefit. McMurtry's unfavorables are up nine points and five times as many primary voters view him unfavorably as view him favorably.

## Thomas Massie's already sizeable lead has grown since April.

Massie now leads McMurtry by 77% to just 11% with 12% of primary voters still undecided.

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## Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 411 likely Republican primary election voters in Kentucky's Fourth Congressional District. Interviews were conducted June 10-11 by live telephone interviewers; 55% of the interviews were conducted to cell phones and 45% were conducted to landline phones. Respondents were selected from the Kentucky voter file with a probability of selection proportionate to their likelihood to vote in the Republican primary election. The survey has a margin of error of +4.9%. Sample was stratified by age, gender, and geography to ensure accurate representation of the primary electorate.
