SUBJECT: VICTORIA SPARTZ LEADS THE INDIANA CD-5 RACE BY SEVEN POINTS

A recent poll conducted by WPA Intelligence on behalf of Club for Growth PAC shows conservative Republican Victoria Spartz with a significant, seven-point, advantage over liberal Democrat Christina Hale.

Spartz leads by seven points with just eight percent undecided.

Victoria Spartz leads with 47% of the vote, compared to just 40% for Christina Hale. Five percent of voters say they are voting for Libertarian Ken Tucker and eight percent are undecided.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 400 likely November voters in Indiana's Fifth Congressional District. Interviews were conducted by live telephone interviewers August 4-6, 2020; 52% of the interviews were conducted to cellphones and 48% to landline phones. The sample was selected from the Indiana voter file and stratified by age, educational attainment, gender, geography, ethnicity, and modeled partisanship to ensure accurate representation of the electorate. The poll has a margin of error of $\pm 4.9\%$.
