SUBJECT: WPAI POLL SHOWS THAT RAUL LABRADOR HAS A SIGNIFICANT LEAD OVER INCUMBENT

LAWRENCE WASDEN IN THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY ELECTION FOR IDAHO ATTORNEY GENERAL

A WPA Intelligence poll of Idaho Republican Primary Voters conducted on behalf of Club for Growth PAC March 7 - 9, 2022, shows that Raul Labrador has higher name ID than incumbent Attorney General Lawrence Wasden and favorable ratings nearly twice as high as Wasden's. This gives Labrador a significant lead on the ballot and a strong chance to unseat the long-time incumbent.

Raul Labrador has name ID 24 points higher than Wasden's and favorable ratings that are nearly twice Wasden's.

- Raul Labrador is almost universally known to Republican primary voters, with 82% name ID and has a strong 42% favorable rating.
- Lawrence Wasden has just 58% name ID and 23% favorables.

Labrador leads in the Republican primary for Attorney General by 21 points.

- Labrador leads the primary with 35% of the vote compared to just 14% for Wasden.
- Art Macomber receives just 2% of the vote and 49% of primary voters are undecided.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 500 likely Republican primary voters in Idaho. Data was collected by live telephone interview March 7-9, 2022. Forty percent (40%) of interviews were conducted to cell phones and 60% to landline phones. The sample was selected from the Idaho voter file and was stratified by geography, age, gender, and vote history to ensure a representative sample. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.4\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
