A WPAi poll conducted on behalf of Club for Growth PAC from September 25-28, 2023, shows Republican Daniel Cameron pulling within six points of Democrat Andy Beshear in the race for Kentucky Governor. Beshear is below 50% in both of our September polls, reflecting a lack of commitment in the electorate to re-electing him.

Daniel Cameron trails Andy Beshear by just six points.

- Cameron has gained two points over the course of September, moving from 40% to 42%.
- Andy Beshear receives 48% of the vote in both polls.
- Ten percent of voters remain undecided in the latest poll.

Methodology

WPAi conducted polls of n = 500 likely 2023 Kentucky general election voters. Data was collected by live telephone interviews September 5-7, 2023, for the early September poll and September 25-28 for the late September poll. Fifty-five percent (55%) of interviews were conducted to cell phones and 45% to landline phones. The sample was selected from the Kentucky voter file and was stratified by geography, age, gender, party registration, ethnicity, and educational attainment to ensure a representative sample. The surveys each have a margin of error of $\pm 4.4\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
