SUBJECT: RECENT PULSE POLL SHOWS ALEX MEALER MOVING INTO A FOUR-POINT LEAD IN THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY IN TEXAS CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 9.

DATE: FEBRUARY 12, 2026

A Pulse Decision Science poll of n = 400 likely Republican Primary voters in Texas CD-09, conducted February 9-11, 2026, shows that Alex Mealer has gained ten points on the ballot and moved into an four point lead.

ALEX MEALER HAS GAINED TEN POINTS SINCE DECEMBER AND NOW LEADS BRISCOE CAIN BY FOUR POINTS.

- Alex Mealer has strong momentum and has gained ten points on the ballot in less than two months. She now leads by four points with 29% of the vote.
- Briscoe Cain has not gained any ground and is still at 25%.
- Steve Stockman and Dan Mims each have 6% and Dwayne Stovall is at 3%.
- Four other candidates total 6% of the vote and 25% are undecided.

Methodology

Pulse conducted a poll of n = 400 likely 2026 Republican primary voters in Texas CD-09. Data was collected February 9-11, 2026, by live telephone interviews. Seventy percent (70%) of interviews were conducted to cell phones and 30% to landlines. The sample was selected from the Texas voter file and was stratified by geography, age, gender, vote history, and educational attainment. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.9\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
