SUBJECT: PULSE DECISION SCIENCE POLL SHOWS THAT BARRY MOORE STARTS THE ALABAMA SENATE PRIMARY RUNOFF ELECTION WITH A 17-POINT LEAD.

DATE: MAY 26, 2026

A Pulse Decision Science poll of n = 518 likely Republican primary voters in Alabama, conducted May 17-18, 2026, shows that Barry Moore is in a strong position to start the Republican primary runoff election for Alabama Senate.

BARRY MOORE BEGINS THE RUNOFF CAMPAIGN WITH A 17-POINT LEAD AND MORE THAN 50% OF THE VOTE.

- Moore begins with 53% of the vote.
- Jared Hudson begins at 36% and 11% are undecided.

Methodology

Pulse conducted a poll of n = 518 likely Republican primary voters in Alabama. Data was collected May 17-18, 2026, by live telephone interviews. 80% of the interviews were conducted to cell phones and 20% to landlines. The sample was selected from the state voter file and was stratified by region, gender, age, educational attainment, and vote history. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.4\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
