SUBJECT: MARK LAMB LEADS THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY FOR CONGRESS IN ARIZONA'S FIFTH DISTRICT WITH 61% OF THE VOTE.

DATE: JULY 6, 2026

A Pulse poll of n = 400 Republican primary voters in Arizona's Fifth Congressional District, conducted June 29 – July 1, 2026, shows Mark Lamb leads Daniel Keenan by 34 points.

LAMB LEADS BY 34 POINTS WITH MORE THAN THREE-IN-FIVE VOTES.

- Lamb leads with 61% of the vote.
- Daniel Keenan has 27% of the vote and 12% of primary voters are undecided.

LAMB'S MORE THAN TWICE KEENAN'S NAME ID AND LAMB'S FAVORABLES ARE MORE THAN TWICE HIS UNFAVORABLES.

- Lamb has 92% name ID and 59% favorable ratings to just 26% unfavorable.
- Keenan has just 45% ID and 20% favorable to 13% unfavorable

Methodology

Pulse conducted a poll of n = 400 Republicans primary voters in AZ CD-05. Data was collected June 29 – July 1, 2026, by a combination of live telephone interviews and SMS-to-web surveys. 68% of interviews were conducted by live calls to cellphones, 12% by SMS, and 20% by live calls to landlines. The sample was selected from the Arizona voter file and was stratified by gender, age, geography, education, and primary vote history. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.9\%$ at the 95% confidence level.
